HSE division concerned over injection centre beside its office

A SECTION of the HSE has issued a tender for a controversial drug injection centre - and then objected to it being located beside its own offices.

The bizarre situation has led one minister to tell the Irish Mail on Sunday that this will likely mean the project will 'never progress'.

The Health Business Services unit of the HSE, which is based in Merchants Quay in Dublin city centre, the same area as the proposed injection centre, raised fears of: safety of residents and workers; anti-social behaviour; a shortage of gardaí; individuals defecating on the streets and parishioners being too scared to go to Mass.
